OIBR Pivot Funds 2025

Foundation Funding

The OIBR Pivot Fund 2025 allows researchers to continue to conduct important work while responding to the current funding climate. Funds can be used to collect data, purchase data sets or equipment, or for other needs as identified by the investigator. Funds cannot be used for travel or personal funding (faculty or student).

The first page of the application should contain two paragraphs: 1) a brief explanation of current work, and 2) a description of how the funds support a pivot to a new direction. The second page of the application should contain the budget and project timeline.

The budget is up to \$5,000. We will consider all applicants, although priority is given to early-career investigators.

Applications will be reviewed starting March 17, 2025, with a rolling deadline after the initial review. Review will be conducted by the OIBR Leadership Team. Applications should be submitted as a single pdf to Andrea Horsman (ahorsman@uga.edu), with the subject line "Pivot Funds."

Policy Updates

NIH Requires PI's to Use The SciENCv Common Forms

After May 25, 2025, NIH is requiring PIs to use the SciENCv Common Forms for Biographical Sketch and Current and Pending (Other) Support to be used with all applications and Research Performance Progress Report(s) (RPPRs). NIH will implement the Common Forms without change to any collection fields. However, in accordance with NIH's Peer Review Regulations at [42 Code of Federal Regulations Part 52h](#), NIH currently plans to continue collecting three required agency-specific data elements (i.e., Personal Statement, Contributions to Science, and Honors) to assess qualifications. **These data elements will be**

collected separately from the Common Forms on a new NIH Biographical Sketch Supplement.
